COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course examines how to provide equitable assessments and interventions for transgender individuals. Many providers are uncertain on how to provide inclusive and ethical services to individuals with gender dysphoria. This training will explore the trans experience and transition journey while taking into account family and community perspectives. Participants will acquire a better understanding of how to work with transgender individuals and become a more inclusive and safer provider.

The workshop will address these issues through a combination of interactive dialogue, focused discussion, applied-practice exercises, and small group work.
